

Advanced Technology For Precision And Quality In Gulf Extrusions

Gulf Extrusions, one of the largest aluminium extrusion plants in the Gulf region, is committed to delivering high-quality products and services to its customers.

To ensure the accuracy and consistency of its extruded aluminium cylinder profiles, Gulf Extrusions uses the Aberlink 3D Mk4 CMM, a state-of-the-art coordinate measuring machine that can perform fast and precise measurements of complex geometries.





The Coordinate Measuring Machine (CMM) is a highly versatile and user-friendly device capable of operating in both manual and Computer Numerical Control (CNC) modes.

Equipped with a sensitive touch probe, the machine is capable of accurately capturing data points on the surface of cylinder profiles. In conjunction with cutting-edge software, the collected data can be analyzed and compiled into comprehensive reports, showcasing the machine's robust capabilities.

The software, Aberlink 3D, is widely considered to be the most easy-to-use measurement software in the industry, as it has a graphical user interface that guides the user through the measurement process.

This machine can measure various parameters of the cylinder profiles, such as diameter, length, roundness, straightness, concentricity, and perpendicularity. It can also compare the measured values with the nominal values specified by the customer or the design.

The accuracy of the CMM is plus or minus 3 microns, which means that it can detect even the slightest deviations from the expected dimensions.

By investing in advanced technology and equipment, Gulf Extrusions aims to enhance its quality standards and customer satisfaction.



SUPERVISORS SAFETY MEETING

ENCOURAGING SAFE BEHAVIOR IN THE WORKPLACE

The SSM addressed important topics such as hazard identification and reporting, lessons learned from mobile equipment accidents, and summer safety.

1- Supervisors (Rules & Responsibilities)

At the SSM, the role and responsibilities of supervisors in ensuring a safe working environment were discussed. They were reminded of their obligation to provide a safe workplace, follow safety procedures, and ensure employees receive adequate safety training and resources. Effective communication between supervisors and employees was also emphasized.

2- Identification of Hazards and Reporting
During the meeting, the importance of
hazard identification and reporting was
discussed.

Regular safety inspections and involving employees in the process were emphasized. Reporting near-miss incidents was also stressed as a way to identify potential hazards and prevent future accidents.

3- Lessons Learned from Mobile Equipment Accident (RCA & CA's)

The lessons learned from a recent mobile equipment accident were discussed. Conducting root cause analyses and corrective actions were emphasized to prevent future incidents. The importance of documenting and communicating these lessons to employees to ensure awareness of potential risks and how to avoid them was also stressed.

4- Summer Safety

The final topic discussed at the SSM was summer safety, emphasizing the importance of taking steps to prevent heat-related illnesses. Staying hydrated, taking breaks in cool areas, and wearing appropriate clothing were highlighted. The importance of providing employees with necessary resources and accommodations to work safely in hot weather conditions was also stressed.
