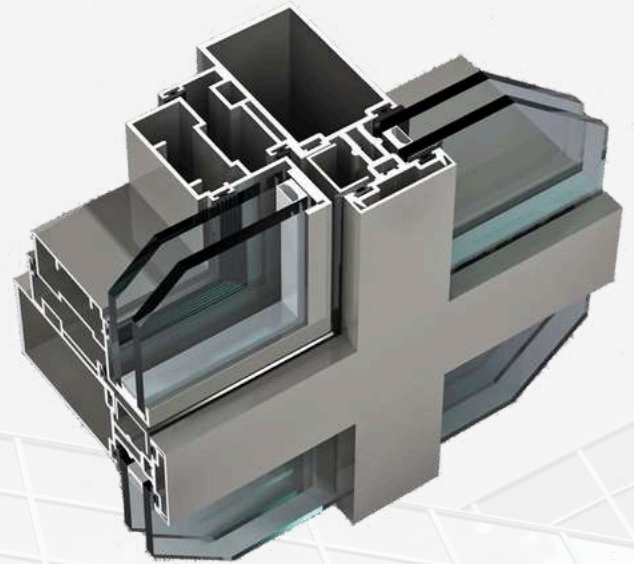

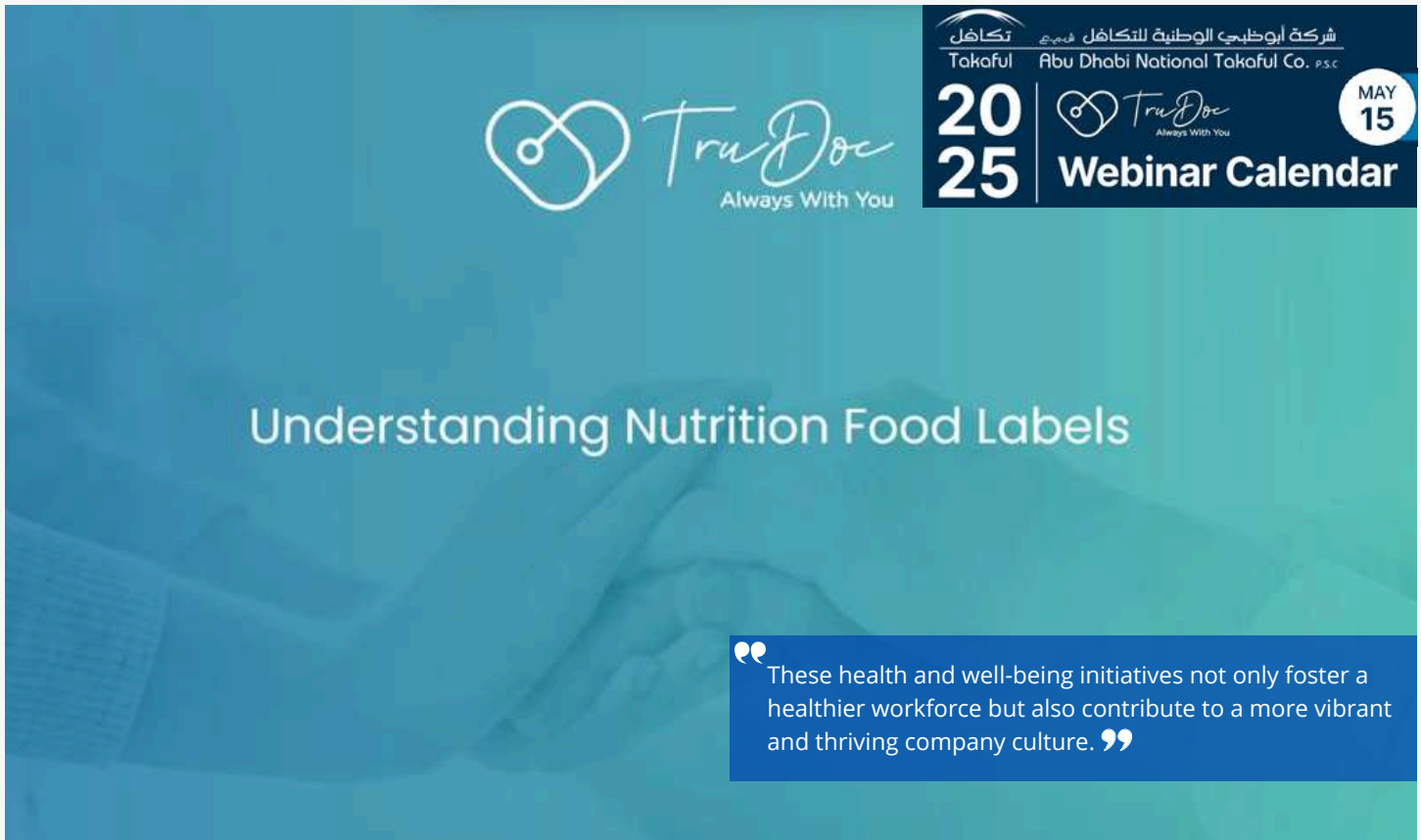

Staying Productive and Refreshed during Summer
